#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Festival Hours are Saturday from 9AM to 6PM. Set-up will begin at 6AM. A 5K event will begin at 7:30AM.
- 2. THE FESTIVAL IS AN OUTDOOR EVENT AND WILL PROCEED RAIN OR SHINE, HOWEVER, INCLEMENT WEATHER DETERMINED TO BE DANGEROUS TO THE PUBLIC WILL CAUSE CLOSURE OF THE FESTIVAL.
- 3. There will be <u>NO EARLY SHUTDOWN</u> and <u>NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE</u>
  FESTIVAL GROUNDS DURING FESTIVAL HOURS.
- 4. FULL PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION AND DATED WAIVER. MONIES WILL BE RETURNED IF APPLICATION IS NOT ACCEPTED.
- 5. A NOTIFICATION WILL BE MADE AFTER APPLICATION IS ACCEPTED AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER APPLICATION IS ACCEPTED.
- 5. Spaces are offered on a first-come first-served basis.
- 6. Vendor IS required to provide his/her own set up, including tables, chairs, extension cords, etc. If you furnish your own tent, sufficient tent tie downs and weights are required. Tent stakes are allowed.
