In consideration for participating in TroutFest 2020, which is sponsored by the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce I hereby release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue, and agree to hold harmless for any and all purposes, the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce, and their representatives from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me while participating in such activity, or while on the premises that is owned, leased, or controlled by the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce including travel to and from the Festival's activities, including injuries sustained as a result of the negligence of the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce.

Exhibitor agrees that Exhibitor is solely responsible for any loss or damage to its property while the same is in transit to or from the SHOW, or while Exhibitor's property is at the SHOW. Exhibitor agrees that within the confines of the space (s) contracted for by the Exhibitor, the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce nor their representatives shall be held liable or responsible for property loss, property damage, or any bodily injury to the Exhibitor or Exhibitor's employees, guests or visitors while at the FESTIVAL. Exhibitor is responsible for obtaining appropriate insurance coverage.

Exhibitor shall be liable for any property damage or personal injury to any individual caused by Exhibitor or Exhibitor's employees or representatives. Exhibitor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce, its officers and employees from and against all claims, actions, suits, demands, proceedings costs, damages, and liabilities, arising out of, connected with, or resulting from any acts or omission of Exhibitor or any employee or representative of Exhibitor participating in the FESTIVAL.

In the case of hazardous weather conditions (tornado), FESTIVAL will close for the protection of attendees and vendors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Festival Hours are Saturday from 9AM to 6PM. Set-up will begin at 6AM. A 5K event will begin at 7:30AM.
2. **THE FESTIVAL IS AN OUTDOOR EVENT AND WILL PROCEED RAIN OR SHINE, HOWEVER, INCLEMENT WEATHER DETERMINED TO BE DANGEROUS TO THE PUBLIC WILL CAUSE CLOSURE OF THE FESTIVAL.**
3. There will be NO EARLY SHUTDOWN and NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FESTIVAL GROUNDS DURING FESTIVAL HOURS.
4. **FULL PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION AND DATED WAIVER. MONIES WILL BE RETURNED IF APPLICATION IS NOT ACCEPTED.**
5. **A NOTIFICATION WILL BE MADE AFTER APPLICATION IS ACCEPTED AND NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER APPLICATION IS ACCEPTED.**
5. Spaces are offered on a first-come first-served basis.
6. Vendor IS required to provide his/her own set up, including tables, chairs, extension cords, etc. If you furnish your own tent, sufficient tent tie downs and weights are required. Tent stakes are allowed.
7. Vendor is responsible for cleaning his/her own area, disposing of trash in the appropriate areas and returning the festival area to its original condition.
8. Each space allotment is 10' x 10'. Additional space can be purchased at a fee.
9. You will be notified by email of your acceptance.
10. Your Sales Tax Certificate must be displayed in booth during Festival hours.
